



## Play the Game 'I Spy'

### Activity:

Play the game 'I spy/see with my little eye'. Think of something in the room or street beginning with a particular sound and then try to get your child to guess what it is.

"I spy/see with my little eye something beginning with C" (use the letter sound of the initial letter of the word)

Your child has to guess what it is e.g. 'c-c-car'.

### Learning:

– Building listening and attention skills – Exploring and identifying the initial sound in words – Building communication and language skills – Learning how to identify letter sounds in words – Supporting your child's literacy skills

## Play an Alphabet Game

### Activity:

Play a game – how many things can you think of that begin with a certain letter/sound of the alphabet? E.g. B - bag, book, boy. Now try this with people's names – e.g. Mathew, Mark, Mohammed

### Learning:
